

Christmas Open House

This is a wonderful, fun-filled fund(d)raiser. It is not a competition, it just gives people the opportunity to decorate their homes and share their creativity with others.

In early Fall, ask six to eight – no more than ten people to participate in a Christmas Open House

Set the date early in December – first or second weekend

People can decorate their homes in anyway suitable to them. It can have a theme; they can display any collection they may have, etc.

Provide maps, directions, hostess name, address and phone number

People sign up to go on the tour and purchase tickets – suggested price \$10. The map and directions, etc can be the ticket.

If people come together, each person pays the fee.

Set a time for the tour -- 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Provide clean room booties or ask people to remove shoes before touring the house

Do not serve refreshments. It's messy and time consuming

Raffle gift baskets prior to the day of the Christmas Tour and the raffle can take place at a specific time on the day of the tour. Winner does not need to be present to win.
