

## **2021 PRAYER FOCUS**

*May we pray for the following as often as the Spirit convicts and brings to memory.*

- 1. That we would put God first, allowing him to fill our hearts, to manifest the fruit of the Spirit.**  
*"So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh...[for] the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law..." (Gal 5:16-26).*
- 2. That we would be Awake and Responsive to the still small voice of God.**  
*"Therefore keep watch because you do not know when the owner of the house will come back—whether in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or at dawn. If he comes suddenly, do not let him find you sleeping. What I say to you, I say to everyone: 'Watch!'" (Mark 13:35-37)*
- 3. That a culture of Listen, Listen, Love, Love would be fostered between Inmates & Custody, and within our communities; cultivating deep & meaningful relationships.**  
*"That their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ" (Col. 2:2)*
- 4. That the Lord would become Real to the Inmates, driving a passion to their faith.**  
*"They asked each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?'" (Luke 24:32).*
- 5. That God would Bless the Administration, Staff, and Custody of R.J. Donovan.**  
*"...let your ear be attentive and your eyes open to hear the prayer your servant is praying before you day and night for your servants, the people of Israel. I confess the sins we Israelites, including myself and my father's family, have committed against you..." (Nehemiah 1:4-11).*
- 6. That we would be F.A.T. for Christ (Faithful, Available, & Teachable).**  
*"Everything is possible for one who believes" (Mark 9:23); "Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here am I. Send me!'" (Isa. 6:8); "Blessed is the man whom You chasten, O Lord, and whom You teach out of Your law" (Ps. 94:12).*
- 7. That while On The Way, God would reveal to us how to Share Kairos with others.**  
*"Jesus and his disciples went on to the villages around Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked them, 'Who do people say I am?'" (Mark 8:27).*
