Continuing Ministry is the heart of Kairos. Everything we do leads to Continuing Ministry. This is where real change happens. Where Kairos Outside Community comes together to do life together. Kairos Outside Continuing Ministry consists of Reunions and S.W.A.P.



What is a Reunion?

A Reunion is an event hosted by your local Kairos Community to help continue and grow the support system started on the Kairos Outside Weekend.

They give the Kairos Outside Community an opportunity to meet and socialize, offering consistent exposure in sharing their lives with others.

Who can attend a Reunion?

Kairos Outside Reunions are open to all former Guests, their spouses and possibly children, potential Guests, and team members (male and female).

When are Reunions?

Reunions are held 4 times a year. The date, time, and location are all determined by your local Kairos Outside Community.

Transportation help can be arranged for anyone needing it, just notify someone in the Community.

What happens at a Reunion?

Reunions take on many forms. Most Reunions have a time of sharing, activity, prayer, music, and of course...food! Sometimes there is a theme or event surrounding the Reunion.

What is a S.W.A.P.?

S.W.A.P. stands for Share, Witness, Account, and Prayer. S.W.A.P. Groups are small groups that show God's love through support to others. We use the acronym S.W.A.P. to remember the format of the group.

The formation of S.W.A.P. Groups started on the Kairos Outside Weekend and continues through Reunions. These groups can be the same people from your table family or ladies on the Weekend you attended.

Who can attend S.W.A.P.?

S.W.A.P. is open to all Kairos Outside Guests and Volunteers who have completed a Kairos Outside Weekend.

When is S.W.A.P.?

S.W.A.P. can be held as often as the group decides to meet. After a group of Kairos Outside Community decide to form a S.W.A.P. Group, they discuss the best day and time to meet as well as the frequency.

S.W.A.P. Groups are designed to last around an hour with all members having an equal opportunity to share. But no one is ever asked to share or do something that they don't want to share or do.

What happens at S.W.A.P.?

S.W.A.P. has a specific format that follows the acronym. Each member of the group is given the opportunity to share, witness about a time they've seen Jesus' love, affirm each other, and pray for each other. There is a card to help guide the meeting that each group uses.
