A Ministry Collaboration of Christian Chaplains & Coaching and Kairos Prison Ministry

All Chaplains of Christian Chaplains & Coaching are accepted to serve as Clergy on any Kairos weekend.

Welcome to Christian Chaplains & Coaching, we're glad you're here. We are happy to announce a ministry collaboration with Kairos Prison Ministry for Chaplain training, ordination, endorsement, and continuing education.



After being accepted and completing the Christian Chaplains & Coaching "Chaplains Academy" curriculum, a person may become an Ordained Chaplain. These courses are offered to mature biblical protestant Christians who have a minimum of a High School Diploma. All courses are offered on-line and taught within a Protestant Evangelical Christian worldview. All Chaplains must complete at least 20 hours of CE per year, in the belief that "a disciple is a student who learns and applies their learing to a changed life, so that they make continuous progress." Christian Chaplains & Coaching requires two courses for ordination and endorsement: 1. The Basics of Chaplaincy, and 2. Certificate in Biblical Counseling for Grief. Kairos further requires a chaplain who serves on weekends to take the certificate in Prison Ministry within two years of ordination. Serving in Kairos will fulfill some CE hours per Christian Chaplains & Coaching guidelines.

Christian Chaplains & Coaching also offers courses to become "Board Certified Chaplain" for those people wanting to become professional board certified Chaplains. We also participate with several Seminaries offering a Masters Degree that includes our biblical approach to accredited Clinical Pastoral Education.

CLINICAL PASTORAL EDUCATION (CPE)

We teach CPE that is fully accredited and recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. We offer CPE in an online format while you earn clinical hours in a local setting of your choice. We teach professional chaplaincy in collaboration with a growing number of Christian Universities and Seminaries. Our CPE can provide Masters level earned credit.



Clinical hours can be earned in a variety of settings right where you live. This can include any combination of ministry opportunities where you provide spiritual care at work or as a volunteer. We can approve appropriate venues that will work in your setting. This can include the hours you volunteer with Kairos Prison Ministry.

Our CPE is accepted nationwide by many organizations. It qualifies for Board Certification through several credentialing agencies. We have been recognized and approved for ordination and endorsement by the U.S. Veterans Administration Hospitals and the Federal Bureau of Prisons.

CPE is provided three times per year in a semester format. There are four courses to complete: CPE 100 through 400. Our program is designed especially for students, pastors, chaplains, and pastoral care interns who have a higher educational degree. It is possible to enroll in our program with bachelor's degree or higher. Certification as BCC, BECC, or BCAC depends on your degree. For full Board Certified Chaplain you must have an MDiv or higher.
